Herewith enclosed, I hand you copy of Petition and Clerk's Taxation of Costs in the case in Perry Circuit Court of Henry Campbell v. L & E, etc.

I have approved the cost bill for a total of \$7.75. I have been unable to obtain copy of final Order for this case. It appears, however, that this case and a large number of others were consolidated with the suit of Dupont Powder Company Co. v. L & E Ry. Co. and Jones-Davis Co., and one final omnibus order was entered covering all of the claims, and I have no doubt that one or more copies of this omnibus order were sent to Louisville. As you doubtless know, Mr. E. S. Jouett had charge of the winding up of these lien claims and he will no doubt confirm my impression that copies of the final order covering all the claims has been sent in. Wootton & Morgan advise me that as to the costs, they were instructed by Mr. Jouett, after the final settlement of all the claims, to get up the bills of costs and send them in for payment. If this is satisfactory, please have voucher issued at your first opportunity in favor of Lee Daniel, Clerk of Perry Circuit Court.
