Dear Sir:-

Referring to the suit of A. D. Campbell v. L. & N. R. R. and T. W. Smith, filed in the Perry Circuit Court on the 15th of March, 1913, for damages in the total sum of \$3,650.00, for destruction of buildings caused by accidental explosion of a storehouse of dynamite, on my return last week from Hazard, I had an opportunity to notice somewhat the conditions of Campbell's property at Yerkes, and my judgment is that \$100.00 or \$150.00 at the outside, would cover all of the damage caused to his residence, store house, barn and other buildings by this explosion. It occurred to me that, if one of our agents could arrange to photograph these buildings right away, that it would be of some service to us in the event this case ever reaches a trial. If you cannot yourself attend to this, will you kindly pass this letter on to Mr. Warfield and it can be left to him to determine whether any such action shall be taken.
