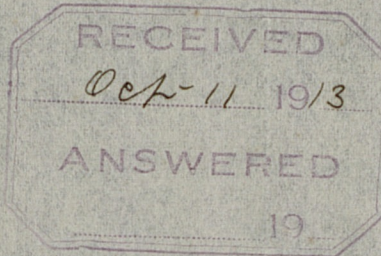




Dear Sirs:-
