

Gentlemen:-

Refer to Judge Wilson's letter of July 5th to me, case of A. D. Campbell to recover damages alleged ~~done~~ to cow during the past Spring. Our Claim Agent says he made every effort possible to settle with Mr Campbell for the slight damage that was done. The report from the Section Foreman indicates that on February 7th a calf the property of A.D. Campbell was crippled, and valued by Mr Combs at \$25.00, and by the Section Foreman at \$10.00 as the total. The Claim Agent offered \$10.00 in settlement which he says was in his opinion at least three times the actual damage. The calf was appraised by Charlie Stidham and Louis Bates of Yerkes Kentucky and they place the amount at \$10.00.
