

Deed # Samuel H. Blair (widower), Margaret E. Blair (single woman), Francis Blair (single woman), Benton M. Blair & wife, Flora Blair, W. H. Blair & wife, Sarah Blair, James M. Day & wife, J. M. Day to L. & E. Ry. Co. - Sept. 23, 1910 - Cons. \$250. R.W. 40' each side E, begin at L.L. bet. grantors and Benton Blair at or near the Co. Road. Said L.L. being at or near Const. Sta. 74+45.
