The Government Publications Department has access, free of charge through December, to Legi-Slate, a database which provides full-text access to the Congressional Record, Federal Register, Code of Federal Regulations, and all bills and public laws for the current Congress. Training in the use of the system is scheduled for Monday, August 22 in a small group setting, but individual training can be scheduled by calling Sandra McAninch at 7-8400. You may also come by Government Publications and read the documentation.

A demonstration copy on floppy disk of the Library of Congress' new subject headings on CD-ROM is available for inspection in Government Publications. Call 7-8400 to make arrangements to inspect the copy. (Submitted by Sandee McAninch.)

The U. S. Postal Service has a new service available that allows users to send them a mailing list on a floppy disk. The Postal Service will then clean up, correct, and add the nine-digit zip codes to all the records at no charge. REMOTE ACCESS PHONE NUMBER CHANGED

The Computer Center has changed the phone number and parameters for accessing the University telecommunications network. This means that remote access users will need to change both the phone number and the parameter settings for logging into LS/2000. The new phone number, 257-9200, is being phased in now; for a while both the new and the old number (257-4861) will work.

Do not change parameter settings for the old phone number. For the new number parameter settings are 8-bit word, 1 stop bit, no parity.
