To ensure that your Work Study students are paid for this pay period, the following steps must be followed:

1. Complete two time reports for this pay period.

a. The first time report must reflect only the hours worked in June (June 26-30). Any hours for June that are not reported this pay period cannot be paid at a later date.

b. The second time report must reflect only the hours worked in July

for this pay period (July 1-9).

2. The time report must be in the Work Study Office not later than 4:30 on Friday, July 9th. Time reports cannot be accepted any later than this date to pay students on July 16th.
