Dark-eyed American Negro.

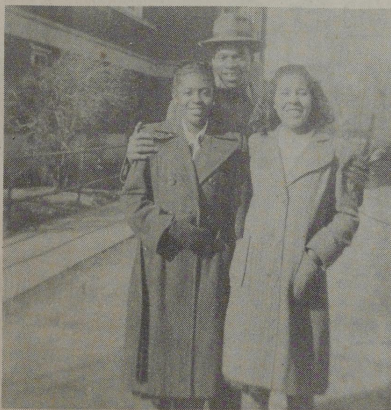
