

The Executive Committee of State University of Kentucky met in regular session at President Barker's office, April 21, 1915. Present: C.B. Nichols, P.P. Johnston, G.G. Brock, John E. Brown.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

President Barker then read his report, which was ordered filed.

Came then the deans of each of the six colleges and filed their respective reports, as directed by the Executive Committee, which are ordered filed, and copies of same will be made and sent to each member of the Board of Trustees.

Upon motion made and unanimously carried, Messrs. Nichols, Stoll and Johnston were appointed as a Committee to act with the President in making up the budget for the next year (fiscal). They to report at the next meeting of this committee.

On motion made and seconded and unanimously carried, the Registrar was directed to issue a diploma to William F. Young, from the College of Law, which has heretofore been approved by the general Faculty.

Upon motion of Mr. Brock and seconded by Mr. Brown, the College of Law is allowed one hundred dollars to be used in conducting the summer school this year. The roll being called, the vote was unanimous.

President Barker was directed to write out a statement and present it to this Committee, at its next meeting, in regard to the claim of the estate of R. A. Milligan, who lost his life while in the employment of this University as a carpenter.

On motion made, seconded and carried, the Executive Committee adjourned to meet at the next regular meeting in May.
