

A + M. College of Ky Nov. 1 - 1907.

The faculty met in the president's room at 3.30 P. M. those present being, Pres. Patterson, professors J. G. White, Neville Patterson, Pryor, Anderson, Mathews, Pease, Mackenzie M. White, Wilson, Gittle, Gumbrod, Rowe, Corbuser.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Prof. M. White presented the request of Miss Goode, a teacher in the public schools, for permission to take up studies irregularly with a view to securing a degree from the college. On motion, this request was referred to the faculty of pedagogy.

On behalf of Prof. Miller, chairman, professor James White read the report of the com. appointed to consider and make recommendations, in regard to entrance requirements. Upon motion it was ordered that consideration of this report be deferred to a special ^{meeting} to be held at 2.30 P. M. Wednesday^{11/6} in Prof. Wilson's Room, and that in the interim additional copies of the report be prepared, and that each member be provided with a copy.

Mr. A. M. Whitlock presented through Prof. Neville, Dean, a request, that, inasmuch as his work for the degree of A. M. was completed before the end of the last session, his minor work, ^{French and Eng.} only not being reported in time, he might receive his degree after the Dec. meeting of the Board of Trustees.

On motion of Dr. Pryor seconded by Prof. Anderson it was ordered that Mr. Whitlock's request ~~be~~ be granted.
