Fred Pierson in Trust the sum of One thousand Dollars for safe investment and with the accumulations, equally divided between his two daughters Daisy and Addie when the youngest one shall come of age.

To my niece Lottie, daughter of Henry L. Pierson Jr. I give One Thousand Dollars.

To my brother George B. Pierson, I give my watch and chain and Five Thousand Dollars.

To my brother Edward F. Pierson I give my seal ring and Five Thousand Dollars.

To my sister Sarah E. Pierson, One Thousand Dollars and to my sister Helen M. Hamilton, One Thousand Dollars.

To the children of my sister Helen M. Hamilton I give Five Hundred Dollars each.
