

law sin? God forbid! Nay, I had not *known* sin, but by the law: for I had not known *lust*, except the law had said, *Thou shalt not covet*.

8 But sin, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin *was* dead.

9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.

10 And the commandment, which *was ordained* to life, *I found to be* unto death.

11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me.

12 Wherefore the law *is* holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

13 Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.

14 For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

15 For that which I do, I *allow* not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.

16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law, that *it is* good.

17 Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

18 For I know that in me, (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no *good* thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.

19 For *the* good that I would, I do not; but the evil which I would not, that I do.

20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present *with* me.

22 For I delight *in* the law of God after the inward *man*:

23 But I see another law in *my* members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity *to* the law of sin which is in my members.

24 O *wretched* man that I am! who shall deliver me from *the* body of this death? *u*

25 I *thank* God, through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

CHAPTER VIII.

1 Who are free from condemnation 5, 13 What harm cometh of flesh, 6, 14 and what good of Spirit, 17 and what of being children.

THERE is, therefore, now condemnation to them who are in Christ Jesus, who walk after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

2 For the law of the Spirit of Christ Jesus hath made freed from the law of sin and death.

3 For what the law could not do in that it was weak through flesh, God, sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, for sin, condemned sin in flesh:

4 That the righteousness of law might be fulfilled in us, walk *not* after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh, but they that are after the Spirit, the things *of* the Spirit.

6 For *to* be carnally minded is death: *but* *to* be spiritually minded is life and peace:

7 Because *the* carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, neither deed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 But ye are not in the flesh, in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell *in* you. Now if man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

10 And if Christ be in you, body is dead because of sin; the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of him who raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he *will* that raised Christ from the dead shall quicken your mortal bodies *by* the Spirit that dwelleth in you.

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not *to* the flesh, to live after the flesh.

13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify *the* deeds of the body, ye shall live.

14 For as many as are led *by* the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage *again* to fear, but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, *whereby* we cry, Abba, Father.

16 The Spirit itself beareth witness *with* our spirit, that we are the children of God:
