My dear darling Sister

I would
have written to you before, but
I just returned from Lexington
yesterday evening. I went up
to my dear Mother's funeral
which took place Thursday
evening at 8 o'clock, every
thing was, as you wished.
The coffin was covered with
the most beautiful flowers
Charley sent up a beautiful
cross of flowers, which he will
sent on to you by express,
but I thought you would
rather have them placed
