

BOARD TO REPORT OFFICER DIED IN LINE OF DUTY

MINNEAPOLIS, April 21.—The death of Lieutenant Charles C. Clay of Lexington, Ky., at Ft. Snelling was from "unknown causes in the line of duty," the report of the Board of Inquiry, which has been investigating the affair, will declare, according to a story published in The Minneapolis Journal.

The finding of the board will not be made public officially here, but must come from Washington.

Lieutenant Clay was found dead in his quarters here last fall, with a bullet wound in his head, and the first inquiry returned a verdict of suicide. The dead officer's father, however, refused to accept such a verdict, and succeeded in having the inquiry reopened.
