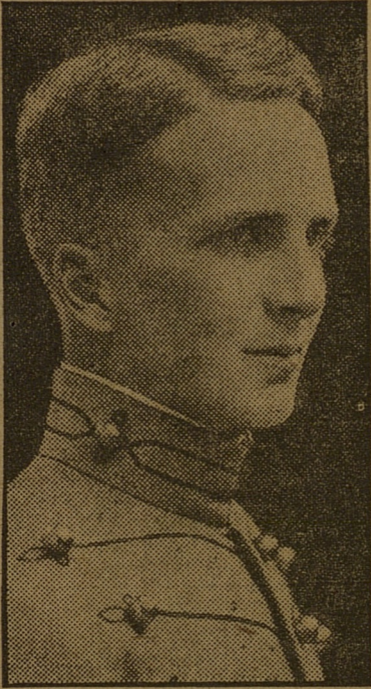

R. P. CLAY WEST POINT GRADUATE

Great-Grandson of Noted Pacificator Is Member of Class Receiving Diplomas Today.

Robert P. Clay, a member of the graduating class at the United States Military Academy, West Point, N. Y., received his commission today and is expected home for a three months' leave before taking up his duties in September.

Cadet Clay is the son of Col. Charles D. Clay, retired army officer and Mrs. Clay, of the Versailles pike, and a great-grandson of Henry Clay, famed pacificator.

He is the representative of one of the oldest and most distinguished families of the Bluegrass, and comes of a line of soldiers.

Cadet Clay attended the Lexington high school, graduating there. He later attended Schadmans, preparatory school for West Point at Washington, D. C. He is well and favorably known in Lexington.

Cadet Clay will be commissioned a second lieutenant and his assignment of duty will be announced later.
