and Louis R. De Rooze as candidates for the Degree
of M. A. & M. S. respectively. It was resolved that
the two gentlemen be informed of the conditions on
which they may obtain this Degree. — It having
been stated that R. De Rooze jr had been implicated
in the affair (drunkenness) of Charles Mason, Freeman
et. al. (See Faculty meeting of Feb. 24th page 170.)
Charles Mason, De Rozier and McCawley are questioned
by the Faculty. Nothing definite is ascertained.
Moved to adjourn to Monday, May 31st. Lost. Moved
by Prof. Merrill that R. De Rooze jr be required to clear
himself of the charge or have his connection with
the College severed — Motion withdrawn. Moved that
the case be referred to the Board of Discipline with
instructions to report on Monday, May 31st 12. M.
seconded. Carried. Faculty then adjourned to meet
in President's Room on Monday, May 31st 12. M. —
