Donelson, who went from this section of Kentucky, are bad clothed
some being nearly in rags, have got some clothing and desire to
send it to them. Mr Hart Gibson who will hand you this
accompanies the goods to see to the delivery of them to the
proper prisoners. I informed him that I did not presume there
would be the least difficulty in getting the goods to Indianapolis
and to his being there enabled to have them properly delivered.
If there are any formalities requisite or any obstacles, will you
please let Mr Gibson know, and I hope you will do what may
be conveniently in your power to facilitate him in accomplishing
the humane objects of the contributors. Respectfully
