

SPRING MEETING-1894.

SPECIAL RULES.

1. Holders of privilege or free badges (except members and complimentary) are required to return the same to the Secretary at the close of the meeting or when they cease to use them; otherwise the Club will enforce its claim for pay for same. Owners, trainers, bookmakers and privilege men will be held responsible for the return of badges issued to employes on their application.

2. Jockeys will be required to make their weights as follows:

For First Race by 1.45 o'clock. For Second Race by 2.15 o'clock. For Third Race by 2.45 o'clock. For Fourth Race by 3.15 o'clock. For Fifth Race by 3.45 o'clock. For Sixth Race by 4.15 o'clock.

Failure to comply with this table will cause the entry to be scratched.

- 3. Jockeys, immediately before mounting, will be required to test their weights on scales kept in their room for that purpose, and upon failure to make such test will be fined or suspended.
 - 4. Races commence each day at 2.30 o'clock P. M. sharp.
 - 5. Dial clock indicates the time each race starts.
 - 6. Thirty minutes between races.
 - 7. Signals: Bell denotes to saddle. Bugle calls horses to post.
- 8. The bugle call will be precisely five minutes after the saddle bell. Horses must go to the post promptly at this signal.
- 9. In stake races the starting fee must be paid prior to weighing the jockey out.
- 10. Horses entered for a handicap or sweepstake race that closes the evenin before, for which entrance money is re-

quired, are not obliged to start; but when two or more horses are entered by the same owner, all or none must start. In handicaps this clause applies only to those accepting the weights.

11. In purses, handicaps and sweepstakes that close during the meeting, four horses of different interests to enter and start, or the race may be declared off by the Executive Committee.

12. In making entries for purse races, the name, age and sex of the horse, and the weight and colors of the rider, must be given. After a horse has run once at the meeting, the name of the horse, with the weight to be carried, is sufficient.

13. Owners not having money to their credit in the Secretary's hands must accompany their entries with the cash in races where a fee is required to start.

14. When more than one horse is nominated by the same party for a handicap, all must be recorded on the same blank. Each nomination for a purse must be made on a separate blank.

15. The weights for all handicaps will be posted on the bulletin, on the days they are due. Should the weight assigned not be acceptable, a declaration must be made through the entry box.

16. The entrance money in all overnight handicaps goes to the winner.

17. In purse races an owner can withdraw his horse by paying five per cent. of the first money, declaration and payment to be made by 12 m. the day of the race. Declarations will be divided, sixty per cent. to the second and forty per cent. to the third horse.

18. The gong will sound in the betting inclosure when the jockeys are officially weighed out. No bet shall be contracted prior to such notification. After the gong sounds, twenty minutes will be allowed for betting.

19. The bell will be rung five minutes prior to closing of the entries, and will be sounded once, denoting the closing of the same, after which no entry to a race or declaration in a handicap will be received.

20. The timers' stand is for persons appointed by the presiding Judge to time the races, and no others.

21. The scalesroom is private, except to jockeys on days they have mounts, and other persons having official business with the Clerk of Scales.

22. No unclosed race on this programme will be withdrawn.

23. The Secretary will be in his office under grand stand from 9 to 12 o'clock A. M., and will pay off programme of preceding day. Positively no settlements made during racing hours.

24. Application for stabling should be made to the Secretary, stating the number of horses to arrive. After application has been made, in case of any subsequent change in the movement of the stable or any part thereof, a prompt notice is earnestly requested.

25. Stabling will not be furnished except for race horses in training.

26. Forfeit orders must be lodged with the Secretary, at the course, by 12 o'clock M. No forfeit will be received except on the day the horse is to run against which it is lodged.

27. The Club reserves the right to charge an entrance fee of \$10 to purse races, if it should deem it necessary so to do. If entrance is so charged it will be divided between second and third horses—60 and 40 per cent.




