A called meeting of the Faculty convened in the President's office, at 9:30 a.m. Dr. Pryor was absent.

The objects of the meeting were to hear the report of the Committee on Award of Honors, and to consider some cases of disorder.

Dr. Hastle moved to take up the case of breach of order committed on the preceding Sunday night, carried. Upon motion Mr. Cooley was summoned before the Faculty and charged with participation in the disorder, and with violation of his arrest. Mr. Cooley pleaded "not guilty". Mr. Dunlap was called in, but could give no helpful evidence. After considerable discussion, upon motion of Prof. Nelson, it was ^{resolved} ~~moved~~ to request the President to take such action in the case of those suspected of sharing in the disorder as he might deem necessary, under section 60 of the Regulations.

Cases of disorder left to Pres't. to deal with under Sec. 60 of Regulations.

The Committee on Award of Honors presented the name of Miss Didlake as valedictorian, and that of Miss Foster as salutatorian. The Committee also recommended that honorable mention be made of all whose class-average is 14 or over.
