Spring semester begins with add-drop session

Officials give tips to make process easier, more productive

Just as the first day after Christmas always marks the beginning of the gift-returning season, Tuesday's centralized add-drop kicks off a UK class-returning season.

Centralized add-drop in Memorial Coliseum for students who advance registered begins at 10 Tuesday morning and lasts until 6, and officials in the registrar's office say this year won't bring any changes in the add-drop procedure.

But they offer some advice on how to make the day a little easier.

Before you get to Memorial Coliseum, and especially if you're changing your college or major, it's a good idea to see an adviser, said Margery McQuilkin, director of student records.

"People have to be careful about relying on the advice of other students," said University Registrar Randall Dahl. "If they're wrong, it can really mess up your program."

"And the advisers will be delighted to see them," he added. "That's what they're interested in doing."

When you get to Memorial Coliseum — and officials stressed that it is pointless to get there before your assigned time — Dahl suggested that along with your student ID and sharp No. 2 pencils, you should bring a little patience.

And "a smile always helps," McQuilkin said. "We tend to take the attitude of the person standing in front of us. It's a long day for everybody."

McQuilkin also suggested that students do a little advance planning

before they go in. She said it is helpful to figure out options ahead of time. That way, if a class or course section is already closed, students won't have to scramble to find another.

She also stressed that if students are changing sections of a class, they need to make sure they top the original section; otherwise they might wind up with an unexpected E on their transcript.

Of course, keep track of what you're doing and always add before you drop.

And afterward, if your full-time or part-time status is changed, you will need to go to the registrar's office,

106 Gillis Building, with your add-drop slips to have your fees reassessed, Dahl said.

For more information on add-drop, students can call the registrar's office at 257-7173.

To accommodate the extra workload, the offices of admissions, advising, registration, fee payment, delinquency clearance and student financial aid will have extended hours. Wednesday, Thursday and next Monday and Tuesday, the offices will be open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. For more information, call 257-2911.

Students may also want to keep in mind that the office of advising and registration has moved from Miller Hall to 207 Gillis Building.

Here are some other dates to remember:

- Monday — Registration for new students.
- Tuesday — Last day to withdraw from the University and receive a full refund.
- Wednesday and Jan. 13, students can withdraw and receive an 80 percent refund. From Jan. 14 to March 5, students can withdraw and re-

ceive a 50 percent refund. After that, no refunds are given. Dahl said it is imperative for students to notify the University upon their withdrawal so they can get their refund.

Wednesday — Late registration for students who did not advance registration or who had their registration dropped for non-payment of the \$50 confirmation fee. There is a \$20 fee for late registering.

Jan. 13 — Last day to add a class.

Jan. 27 — Last day to pay fees in full to avoid cancellation. Fees should be paid in 257 Student Center. Any reinstatement after cancellation costs \$50.

Feb. 12 — Last day to file for a May degree. Undergraduate degree candidates should file in their college dean's office. Graduate students need to file with the graduate school.

March 5 — Last day to drop a class.

UK impressive in December, upsets Louisville and Auburn

Any coach will tell you that one game does not make a season.

But after Kentucky dismantled the University of Louisville Cardinals in Louisville by 34 points, 85-51, the Wildcats appeared to be higher than Cloud 9.

"Some people are saying that this could be the biggest win in Kentucky history," center Rob Lock said after the game.

And Lock was one who played a vital role in the Dec. 27 win. The junior center pulled down seven rebounds to go along with nine points and teamed with running mates Richard Madison and Irv Thomas to shut down everybody's All-American "Never Nervous" Pervis Ellison.

If Ellison was anything, it was nervous.

Lock, Madison and Thomas shut down the Cardinals highly touted front line for 40 minutes while freshman sensation Rex Chapman iced the game from the parking lot with three-pointers after three-pointers after three-pointers.

The Cards' starting numbers — Ellison four points and four rebounds, Herbert Crook six points and seven rebounds and Kenny Payne seven points and one rebound.

Madison, alone, pulled down 17 rebounds, while Thomas yanked down five. And Chapman rewrote the book on the three-point shot, earning five of eight attempts and finishing with a game-high 26 points.

As a team, the Wildcats held a modest 41-33 edge on the boards and hit 11 of 17 three-point shots.

Kentucky's Eddie Sutton, however, said the final score wasn't as disastrous for the Cardinals as it appeared.

"We aren't 34 points better than they are," a pleased UK coach said. "We just played a great game and they just couldn't get on track."

Getting on track is putting it lightly: the Cardinals' train never left the station. UK singed the nets, hitting 54.2 percent from the field, while it held U of L to a season low 36.2 percent.

But as high as the Cats were in routing Louisville out of Freedom Hall, the Georgia Bulldogs were one cloud higher three days later when they visited Louisville for Kentucky's opening Southeastern Conference game.

The inside-outside Wildcat combination that put the clamps on Louisville was left in Lexington, and Georgia managed to escape the River City with a 69-65 upset before 20,053 Cat fans during the annual December game at Freedom Hall.

"There are going to be eight other coaches out there tonight who are going to like me a lot more than they did this morning," an elated Hugh Durham said after the upset. "It's not often that a conference team beats Kentucky on their home floor, and it helps the rest of the league."

Durham's Bulldogs were led by sophomore Toney Mack, who hit 10 of 14 from the field and finished with 24 points. Mack was recently suspended from the squad for the remainder of the season because he failed to pass the required number of credit hours to remain academically eligible.

Chapman's red-hot shooting was cooled by the Bulldogs' man-to-man defense. The freshman hit only four field goals in 14 attempts, two being three-point desperation heaves in the closing seconds of the game after Georgia had closed the door.

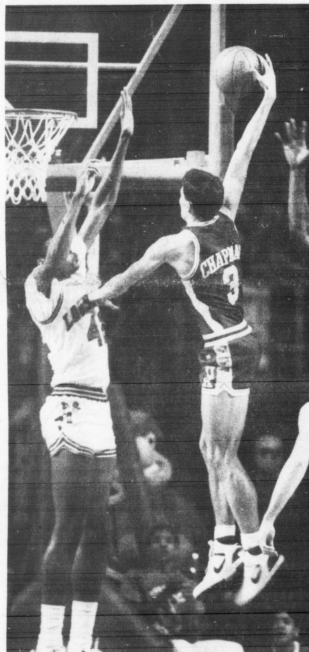
Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, guest tickets can be purchased for all four games at the same time and location. Tickets are \$6.

The next student ticket distribution will begin Feb. 1 at Memorial Coliseum for the Auburn and Tennessee games.

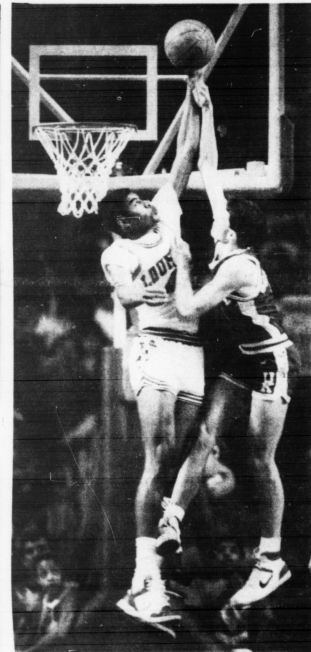
"Rex is going to have nights like this," Sutton said after the game. "He is only a freshman and it's just going to happen."

If Chapman was cold, the rest of the team was frigid. On the night, UK hit only 40.3 percent of its field goals, a season low, and rattled the rim from the three-point range on one of 28 attempts.

"This league is the best the SEC has been for a long time from top to bottom," Sutton said. "There aren't any weak teams in the conference."

though Ellison won this matchup, Chapman and the Wildcats won the Battle of the Bluegrass.

"Overall, and I've looked at enough film to know, this is a heckuva league."

One heckuva game was what the Wildcats played when they traveled to Auburn Jan. 3, where they suf-

fered their only conference loss last season.

Kentucky led by as many as 10 six different times in the second half, before slipping away with a 63-60 win.

Chapman pulled out of his one-game slump and led the pack with 24 points, as he knocked down six of nine three-pointers.

"We have worked extremely hard on the three-point shot," Sutton said.

SAB, SGA scheduling concerts, speakers, other activities for spring semester

Don't fill in all the dates on your calendar for the upcoming semester before you check with the Student Activities Board and Student Government Association.

The two organizations are already gearing up for the semester, planning everything from lectures and concerts to ballooning and spring breaking in sunny Texas.

Topping the list is the Pretenders concert, said Lynne Hunt, SAB president. The concert, featuring special guest Iggy Pop, will be at 8 p.m. Jan. 22 in Memorial Coliseum. Tickets, which are on sale now at the Student Center ticket office, all Disc Jockey locations and Cut Corner, are \$10 and \$12.50.

The UK concert marks one of the first stops on the Pretenders' new tour, Hunt said. "We're really excited that we got them."

SAB and SGA will join forces to bring Terry Waite, special envoy to the Archbishop of Canterbury, to campus Feb. 22. Waite has been in the news of late for his efforts in ne-

gotiating for the release of hostages in Beirut.

The organizations booked Waite last semester for \$10,000, SGA President Donna Greenwell said. The lecture will be at the Center for the Arts.

Hunt said Waite represents the organizations' efforts to bring quality, as well as popular, lecturers.

"He is currently still very much in the news," she said. "I think he'll be an excellent speaker," Greenwell said, "but I think we'll have to advertise what he did instead of his name."

Another annual event, the Little Kentucky Derby, is set for April 8-11 and should follow basically the same format as last year, featuring a carnival, running for rose and rednets and the balloon race, Hunt said.

Students who want to save a few dollars on the books they need for the semester can stop by a temporary bookstore on the first floor of the Student Center this week. The Book Exchange, which is sponsored by SGA and operated by Chi Omega sorority, has collected about 150 books and will offer them at prices below that of the local bookstores, Greenwell said.

The Spotlight Jazz Series will continue with a concert by up-and-coming jazz artist Bobby McFerrin, of Levi's 501 jeans commercial fame, Hunt said. McFerrin will perform Jan. 30 in Memorial Hall. Tickets for the concert are available for \$9 at the Student Center ticket office.

Closing out the series will be the Modern Jazz Quartet, which will perform Feb. 20 at the Center for the Arts. Tickets are \$12.

The University turns a year older, which gives reason to celebrate Feb. 19. Hunt said SAB is working to provide events more interesting to students "other than a free piece of cake."

Students can sign up now in the outing center in 101 Student Center and reserve their spot with a \$50 deposit. Students who sign up before Feb. 2 pay \$282 for bus transportation, hotel and activities such as wine and cheese parties, she said. After that date, the package costs \$292.

"I'm sure we'll have a lot of other concerts and lectures pop up as the semester goes on, but that's what's planned now," she said.

Hunt said she's proud of SAB's programming for past semesters, and "we're very, very excited about this semester. We feel like we've got a good start on it."
