Memorandum of agreement by and between
J. D. Amos^{sr} and J. Schillinger for rent of the
Joe Gline farm now owned by me for the
year 1884 commencing with said year and
expiring with the same. Schillinger executes
two notes to Amos. one for six hundred dollars
(\$600.00) payable 20th July (1884) the other for six
hundred dollars (\$600.00) payable 25th December
same year and if the wheat crop justified
at both notes to be paid off on date of first.
He shall sow not less than eighty acres
wheat one hundred if he can in time not to
plow up the clover or grass now on the
farm to cultivate all in good farming like
manner husbanding its products in proper
time and in good order then when delivered in
market and that which he may retain or use
at home at its market value should not
(that is) the one half of all he may raise be
(\$200.00) after the rent of pasture seventy-five
dollars is subtracted and if then appears
that it is not worth the cash rent paid
excepting the \$75.00 for pasture)
