Dear

We are to day in debt of your favor of 28th inst. covering Chk on New York for five thousand Dollars to order of Col B M Kelly Collector 7th District as stated. The Collector will not take Chks on N.Y. in payment of taxes, hence the trouble here in getting money on light of N.Y. Our banks too have been over loaded with N.Y. funds and have refused to take them except at a discount. We arranged before telegraphing you with one of our agents to take 5000 of it on N.Y. City. The collector himself is absent but will be at home in a day or so and we hope to be able to send you with him with the 5000 Chk.

We drew light of yesterday on you for twenty six hundred & fifty Dollars which one of our Merchants took from us by check on 1st inst week for the money and we advanced the tax on 120 lbs say \$1670⁵⁰ which is being drawn to day. Please pay the amt when presented. We enclose duplicate list as follows on 105 lbs 131 to 235 inclusive \$2312.50

(105 - 236 - 340 Annually Sunk)
120 341 - 460 inclusive 2670.50
