

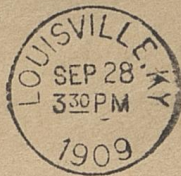

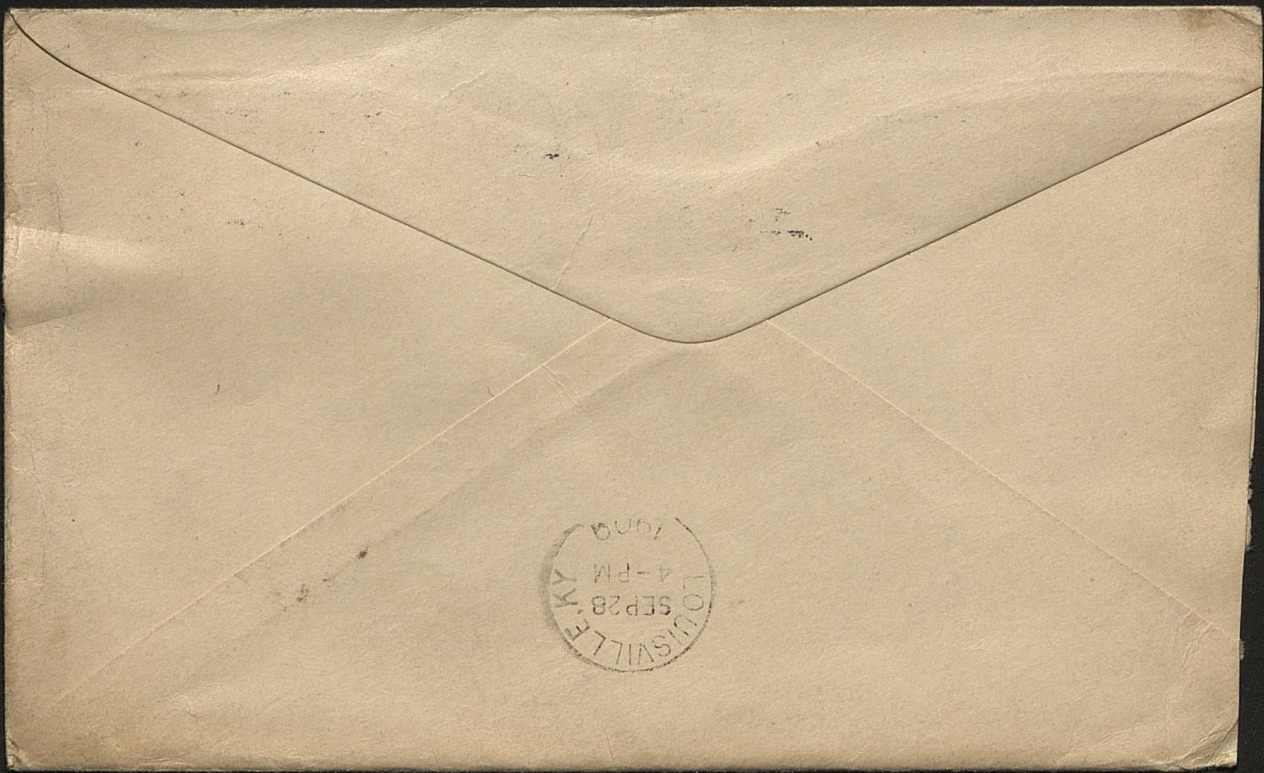

Let us return next September with the determination to make the Louisville schools a most worthy instrument for good.

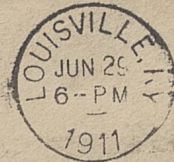
