

April 29th 1904.

The Scientific Faculty met in the Botanical Lecture room with the following present. Prof. White, Miller, Ponce, Kuttel, McKuzer and P. O. O.

Prof. White offered a set of resolutions which had been adopted by the Faculty of the Department of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, with the suggestion they be considered by the faculty.

In res. Murphy's last to propose action until the next session.

The usual course of the standing of students was then recommended - now made and the faculty adjourned.

The following orders were passed unanimously by the Faculty of the Department of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering on April 12th., 1904.

1st,--That no student in Mechanical and Electrical Engineering be admitted to the senior class who has a condition in any subject.

2nd,--That no student be admitted to any junior class who has a condition taught in the Sophomore or Freshman years, due to failure in that subject. (During the year 1904-05 a student may enter the junior year if he has not more than one condition due to failure, after 1904-05 the provision 2nd., will be in effect).

3rd,--That no student be admitted to any Sophomore class who has a condition in more than one subject taught in the Freshman year, due to failure.
