Henderson assisting Mr. Bonard
in a meeting and seeking aid for
Hamesville - I assisted him as
I did Cooke in getting money
here & our people have given
nearly \$400 & aid in building
churches at Hamesville & Lewisport

I shall presume upon my acquaintance with the neighborhood ^{of Jefferson} to make some suggestions to you as representing both Missions and Synod's committee — In the first place I think Livermore twenty miles back of here a most promising point for missionary effort — Your evangelists could I think readily organize a church there to be united with Central City or the Ohio county field in the support of a minister — In the second place at Adairville, the terminus of the O. & N. R.R. a little beyond Russellville I am told there are four

or fine Presbyterian families
who are holding back from the
Cumberland P^{re}sb^{er}ch - in the hopes of
having by & by a church of their
own faith to join - But they shoud
be looked after soon I do not ^{just} now
see how I can comply with their
request & visit them myself - I un-
derstand it is a good town situated in
a fine country - Can't you send
Morrison or Evans over to look
at the field & see what can be done?
