This recreation area is built the site of a pre-Revolutionary tar kiln and tar pit. The kilns were built to extract pitch from pine wood. Pitch was used to caulk the wooden saling alpos of the Brush Navy and is the foreunner of the present day. "Naval Stores" industry.

## U.S. Highway #17

This sanctuary for migratory birds parallels the coast and lies adjacent to the National Forest. Herons, gulls, plowers, terns, ducks and the big white and American egests live in the sheltered of these birds soar inland over the palmettos and live oaks. Bull Island, accessible only by boat, is well known and visited by many nature enthusiasts. The refuge is managed by the Fish & Wildlife Service of the U.S. Dept. of the Interior.

The old estate of Henry Laurens (1724-92), president of the Continental Congress, is now a Trappist monaster, It was donated to the Trappis Order by Clare Booth Luce. Henry Luce, publisher, was buried here in 1967. Only the handsome gaste and mile long avenue of live oaks remain of pre-Revolutionary Mepkin.

## RUINS OF BIGGIN CHURCH

Built in 1756, this church was used as a garrison post by the British. During the War Between the States the communion service with its gilded silver chalice, brought by Huguenots from La Rochelle, France, was buried nearby and never rediscovered.
