## Decentralized Add-drop to begin tomorrow

It was designed to end the long lines of centralized Add-drop at Memorial Coliseum, but instead it caused headaches for students, University employees and officials.

UK officials aren't promising the Student Information System will work any miracles tomorrow when fall Add-drop begins, but they hope there won't be as many hassles.

"I'm not going to stick my neck out and say this is going to be a piece of cake, but we certainly hope it will run smoothly," said Lana Dearing, director of registration and scheduling. "It's a whole new learning process for all of us. But our students have done very well (adjusting to it)."

One way officials have made Add-drop easier is by decentralizing it. Rather than all students going to one location tomorrow,

most students will be able to change their schedules in their colleges.

An advantage of decentralized Add-drop is that students will be able to consult an academic adviser when deciding on which classes to add or drop, Dearing said.

"I think it will be more convenient for students to do it in their own college, so if they need any advice they can get it there," Dearing said.

Michal Morford, an academic adviser in the College of Arts & Sciences, said decentralized Add-drop should save students a lot of "footwork."

"They won't have to run around that much and that's great," she said.

Under centralized Add-drop, Morford said there was a lot of "peer advice going on."

"(Students) need to be close to

an academic adviser (when they go through Add-drop)," she said.

Last semester the University held early and finals week Add-drop. More than 1,500 students took advantage of the program, and of-

officials hope that fewer students will need to go through Add-drop tomorrow.

It's difficult to predict how many students will use decentralized Add-drop tomorrow, Dearing

said. Some students who failed spring or summer courses will want to retake classes this semester, and students who have decided to change their majors may need a new schedule, she said.

"Students should not attempt to go through Add-drop before their time because they will not be admitted," she said. "As a matter of safety and consideration for others, students should not come in advance of their time."

Last spring, officials had hoped that the SIS would mark the end of long lines at Add-drop, but things did not run so smoothly as anticipated.

Lines for Add-drop last spring snaked through the halls of the New Student Center and extended through the doors. In addition to the long waits, many students complained that classes they wanted were closed.

Problems of the SIS included that

the system went down for a while and many people were not accustomed to the new system, officials said.

Another reason was because the Registrar's Office did not expect that such a large number of students would want to change their schedules. More than 2,300 students went through Add-drop on the first day last semester, according to Lisa Collins, registration coordinator.

Decentralized Add-drop should mean shorter lines, but officials are not predicting less hassles.

"How Add-drop goes depends on the operating system, the network, the class availability and human behavior," Dearing said.

Still, the computer system can go down. "If we do have down time, normally (computer services) can bring us back up in a real short time," Dearing said.

## Parking hang tags to be used this fall

UK parking officials say that hang tags should make parking more convenient for students, but they hope that the hang tags do not lead to an increase in stolen parking permits.

All parking permits were switched from window stickers to hang tags this semester so students can transfer parking permits to different cars, said Don Thornton, associate director of parking and transportation.

"We've been talking about changing to hang tags for several years," Thornton said.

The window stickers caused some students problems because some parking permits did not stick to windshields and others were eroded by the weather, Thornton said.

"There were just a lot of problems we had with using the window stickers," he said.

Some universities who use hang tags for parking permits have had a problem with thefts, Thornton said. University faculty and staff have used hang tags for about a year, and all of the stolen parking permits they reported were taken from unlocked cars.

"One thing we do emphasize is that the vehicle (should be) kept locked," Thornton said.

If a car with a stolen or lost tag is spotted by a UK parking control officer, a parking citation will be issued and the car will be impounded, Thornton said. In addition to the \$25 cost to get the car back, the car's owner also will have to pay the hang tag's sale price.

The car's owner also will be referred to UK police, and if the person is a student, he or she will be turned into the Dean of Student's office.

UK police have been citing most individuals found with stolen tags for possession of stolen property and sending them to Fayette County court, Thornton said.

One student who took an A hang tag from a car had to pay more than \$200, had to attend special classes and had to perform 60 hours of community service, according to Betty Wade, UK parking manager.

"It's just not worth (stealing a hang tag in order to) park a little bit closer (to campus)," Wade said.

If a student loans a parking permit to a friend, any parking citations assigned while that individual has the tag will be listed under the owner's name.

If the vehicle is impounded, the tag's owner and the person who borrowed the tag will be charged with falsifying information, Thornton said.

Parking control officers began monitoring C, R1, R3 and R10 areas today. Last year's student permits will be honored through Friday. A vehicle can be impounded for one parking violation, according to UK parking policy.

"There's a myth on this campus that you have to have a certain number of tickets before you get towed," Wade said.

Vehicles with three unpaid citations are placed on a "hot list." A vehicle on the "hot list" is towed if spotted by a parking officer, Wade said.

The parking department will issue numbers reserving C permits in the Student Center Ballroom tomorrow from 8 to 11:30 a.m. Numbers reserving R1, R3 and R10 permits will be issued tomorrow in the ballroom from 1:30 to 4 p.m.

## Summertime news . . . UK basketball hit with probation; faculty salaries raised

While many students were away this summer earning money, vacationing or taking a break from the rigors of academic life, there was plenty of news happening at UK. In the tradition of USA Today, the Kernel has provided its readers with bite-size portions of this summer's news to catch them up with the events that occurred during the last 3 1/2 months.

### UK basketball gets probation

After a yearlong investigation, the NCAA announced in May that the UK men's basketball program

was guilty of two major rule violations.

UK was hit with a three-year probation, which includes no television coverage this year and no postseason play for two years. Chris Mills and Eric Manuel, two of UK's top players, were declared ineligible by the NCAA.

LeRon Ellis and Sean Sutton decided to transfer shortly after the sanctions were announced, leaving junior Reggie Hanson as the only returning starter from last year's squad.

The NCAA also took away UK's earnings from the 1988 NCAA tournament, as well as two victories it earned in that event. The Southeastern Conference then took away

the Wildcats' 37th SEC championship. The penalties will cost the University about \$2 million.

### Rick Pitino named basketball coach

Promising to restore integrity to the once proud Wildcat program, Rick Pitino was named head coach of UK's men's basketball team in June. Pitino comes from New York City, where he spent the last two years coaching the New York Knickerbockers of the National Basketball Association.

While Pitino did not promise Wildcat fans a national championship in 1992, he said at a

press conference this summer that the next two years will be "exciting years for Kentucky basketball."

### Trustees raise faculty salaries

Trying to narrow an increasing gap between salaries at UK and median salaries at comparable institutions, the UK Board of Trustees approved a 7 percent average salary increase for faculty and staff at its June meeting.

To pay for the salary raise, the University's salaries and departments were forced to trim their budgets by about 3 percent. As a result, many colleges will have to

hold vacant faculty positions open longer and some departments may not be able to purchase equipment.

### Hemenway moves into chancellor office

Robert Hemenway took over as chancellor for the Lexington campus July 1, succeeding Art Gallaher. Hemenway, who comes to UK after serving as dean of the University of Oklahoma's College of Arts and Sciences, was chairman of UK's English department from 1981 until he left for Norman, Okla., in 1986.

"I think he understood the needs of a university like UK, the direction we need to go," said Paul Wil-

lis, who chaired the search committee that recommended Hemenway for the post.

### BOT establishes day-care center

Citing a need for faculty, staff and students to have an affordable, on-campus facility for their children, the UK trustees approved the establishment of a campus day-care center.

The center, to be completed by fall 1990, will be located on the corner of Columbia and Woodland avenues and will hold about 135 children.

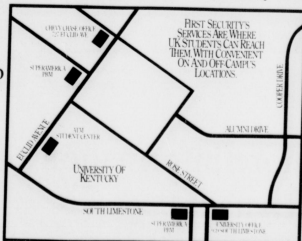

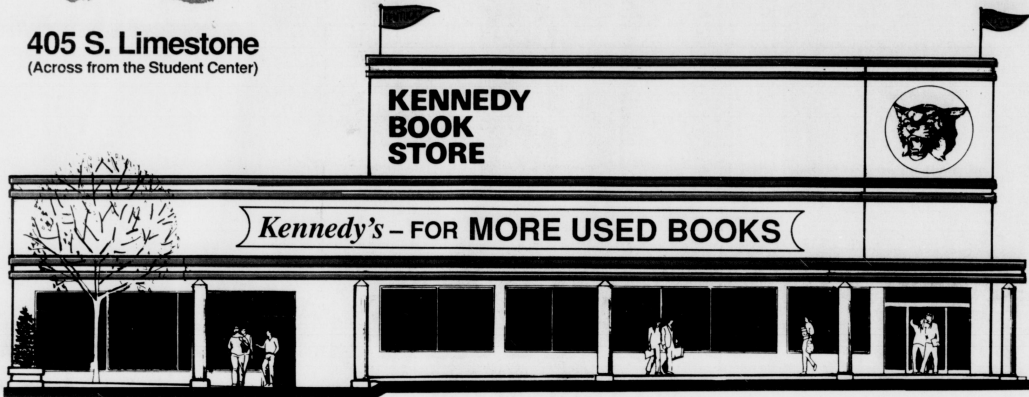




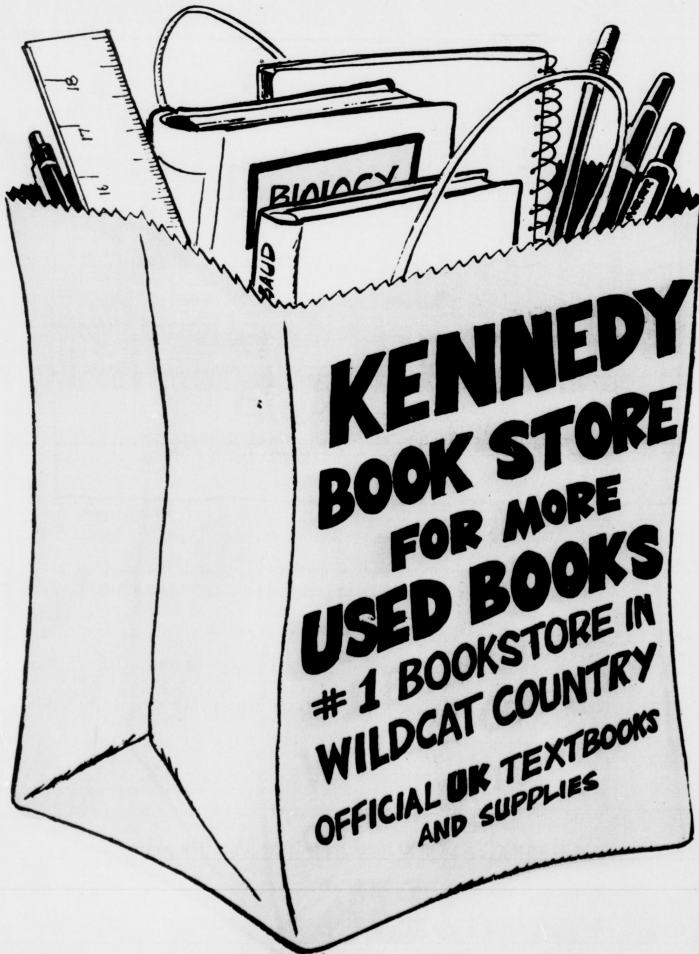
