Dear Caleb:

I saw by the Courier Journal of recent date a synopsis of the affidavits made by Claud Terrell, Abe Renick and others in the counter avowels made by the Commonwealth in regard to the action of legislature just after the killing of Goebel in 1900. As the effort of Franklin, Williams seem to tend to contradicting me I immediately wrote to Claud Terrell calling his attention to the fact that he had said that I was present at the Friday meeting and answered the roll call but did not vote denouncing his statement and further calling his attention to the roll call on page 306 of the Journal demanded by Mr. Finn in which I am not even recorded as being present. While I deemed the Journal as being very poor evidence of anything any of the actual doings of the legislature that the yet it should be sufficient evidence for him to base a statement upon. He wrote me that he would write Williams and correct it. I also intend looking after some of th the others parties that made affidavits there regarding what I did and I would like to have a copy of the affidavits of Eli Brown, Abe Rennick and Claud Terrell, also Allison Holland's. I intend writing the whole matter up for the news papers and showing the falsity of the Journal and at the same time calling some of the parties to account for their affidavits so far as corcerns me.
