

Magnolia Family (*Magnoliaceae*).

Cucumber Tree (*Magnolia acuminata*).—A large tree, sixty to eighty feet high, occurring thruout the State from eastern to western boundaries. Leaves small relatively to those of the next two species, measuring in a specimen before me eleven and a half inches long by seven inches wide; shape, oval. The flower also is small, the petals one and a half to two inches long.

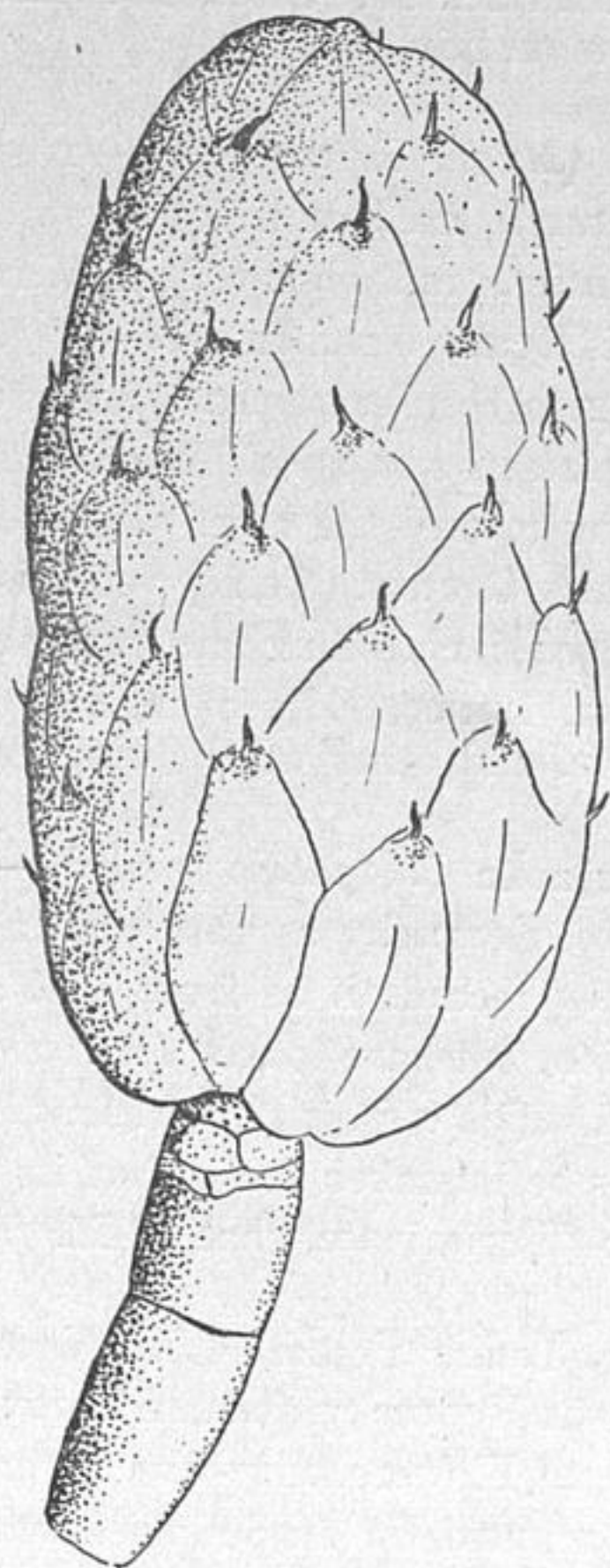


FIG. 14.—FRUIT OF UMBRELLA
