The faculty met in called session at 4 P.M. in the presidents office. those present being President Patterson, Messrs. Neville, W.K. Patterson, Kastle, Roark, Pryor, Miller, Pence, Brooks, Norwood, Byroads, and Munstaine and also <sup>Prof. Scovel.</sup> <sup>by invitation</sup>

Entertainment of Presbyterian Synods. Pres. Patterson suggested the necessity of taking action with reference to the entertainment of the Presbyterian Synods and upon motion of Prof. W.K. Patterson it was ordered that a com. of five be appointed to make all arrangements. Com. appointed Prof. Scovel, Chruin, Profs. Pryor, Roark, W.K. Patterson and Norwood.

Wills, Mr. matriculation of. Pres. Patterson stated that a young man, Wills by name, had applied for admission to the college but that he had delayed his matriculation on account of an intimation that the main chief or main purpose of entering was to secure a position upon the foot ball team for the season.

After considerable discussion it was ordered upon motion of Prof. Neville, seconded by Prof. Roark, that it is the sense of this faculty that upon his compliance with all the regulations governing the admission of students, Mr. Wills should be admitted to the college.

Applications from schools for speakers from college. Prof. Roark presented to the faculty two invitations - from Liberty and Bardston, for representatives of the college to be sent to address teachers institutes at these towns.

Upon motion of Prof. Anderson, it was ordered that Profs. Mackenzie and Winston be requested to fill these two engagements. Adjourned.
