become of my Little girl you asked
if I remember those Little girls I dont
just exactly remember what any of
them Looked Like only Corrie Peters
and she talked to me more than the
others did when I was there but I
remember all the Little children in
the house every night in my Prayers
I am going to send you a box I think
I will get it off the Middle of next
week but I will write to you at
the time I send your box
it is pretty cold here we have had nice
weather till now and it is snowing

to day the ground is white
ada I always forgot to tell you
when I came home I went to see
Mrs Banks and gave her the Pin Lap
you sent her she was very much pleased
she thinks you can sew nicely and I
gave the little one to Arrie Bayley and
she thinks it is so nice she was asking
me to day when you was coming
home I have a class in sundayschool with
eight little girls and they are very
much interested about you they say
you must go to see them all when
you come home

I think I will close my letter for
this time tell jimmy I will answer
his letter as soon as I can Grandpa
Grandma and your Aunties send

I will send you three more cards that I got. for getting under good," Mr and Mrs Hilton are both well and send their love to you We have sewing hour in the after noon: for the large girls and on Thursdays and Fridays the little girls sew. Please come and see us we would be

very glad to see you, I will write
to Jennie and Carrie Clark next
week, I can not think of much this
time, but I will try and think
of more the next time I write,
I do not play with my doll
I want to see how nice I can
keep it for I want to play
with it when I come home,
I sat in the seat with Sallie Farley
and Addie Lope in school, I will
close by saying Good bye from
your loving daughter Addie
