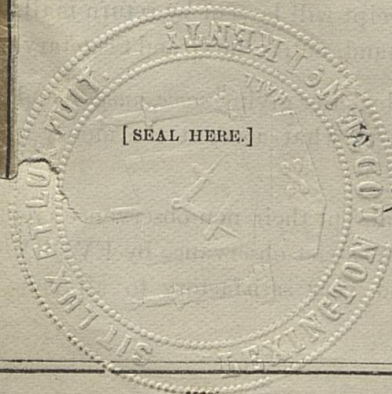

How to make Out Returns.

[Failure to make out returns properly causes much trouble which can be avoided if these directions are carefully followed.]

1. On a sheet of paper write names of officers. Then read the three lines under "Past Masters," page 2, of this blank, and write their names accordingly *on the sheet of paper*. Then read directions on page 3, and write names of M. M's. on the paper. So proceed under each head until the return is completed *on the paper*. Then check off with last return, and see that every name, there reported, is accounted for. Then prove its correctness, on a slip of paper, per forms on 1st page, and "Recapitulation" and "Proof." Now copy it nicely on this blank, filling the blanks properly. Fill and sign certificate properly, and attach impression of seal. Look it over carefully, and then MAIL THIS TO GRAND SECRETARY, LOUISVILLE, KY., BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 1ST. AND 3D. Read the copy to Lodge if desired, BUT DO NOT DETAIN THE RETURN.

2. A minister of the Gospel, *exempt by By-Laws from paying dues*, NOT OTHERWISE, should be so designated by "Rev." prefixed to his name.

3. Returns of Chartered Lodges are made up to September 1st. Lodges U. D. make up returns so as to include their last meeting previous to the meeting of the Grand Lodge.

4. For all Fellow Crafts and Entered Apprentices members of the Lodge, the Lodge must pay dues, even if they have been initiated or passed only the night before the date to which the return is made up. The Grand Lodge does not recognize Honorary or Life members; *all such are to be counted as members of the lodge, and dues paid on them*. Members who have been *affiliated* M. M's. for 50 years are exempt from Grand Lodge dues, and must be designated by the words "50 years" written after their names. In the margin write, "Raised in— Lodge No. —, State of —, — 18—." The "degree" is indicated by the initial letters, thus: "M. M."—for Master Mason, etc.

5. Write the names, etc., *plainly* (Christian names in full). Remarks or notes on the return should not be made.

6. Send the amount due Grand Lodge in check, money-order, or by express, on or before October 1, and receipt will be sent by return mail. If receipt does not come promptly to hand, notify the Grand Secretary.

7. Let remittances be accompanied by letter giving *name, number, and post-office* address of your Lodge, and for what account the money is sent.

8. These matters may appear trivial, but their non-observance creates *confusion, delay, and much trouble*. A strict observance by EVERY Secretary would be business-like and very satisfactory to all concerned.

HOW TO MAKE OUT RETURNS.

[Failure to make returns properly and forward them promptly, causes much trouble and expense.]

1. Commence on page 3, read the heading notes and write in *strictly alphabetical order*, the FULL name of every master mason, member of your lodge, including officers and Past Masters, thus:

Adams, Hiram Henry.

2. After the name of ministers who are made "Free Members" by your by-laws, NOT OTHERWISE, write "Rev." thus:

Hunter, Hiram Abif, Rev.

3. Next, on page 7, write alphabetically, the names of F. C.'s, and E. A.'s under those heads respectively.

4. Read the head-notes on pages 8, 9, and enter the names of all who have been *initiated, passed, or raised* during the year, none others, and fill in the dates carefully.

5. On pages 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 appropriately fill the blanks as indicated under each head, designating the "Degree" thus: "P. M." for Past Master, "M. M." for Master Mason, and so on. Do not leave dates, etc., blank.

6. Turn to page 2, and copy the names of officers, and give date of election. Read head-notes under "Past Masters," and fill accordingly.

7. Check off the entire return by the last return to see if no name has been omitted.

8. Now fill the blanks in page 1, except "Dues to the Grand Lodge of Ky.," and add up, to see if your work is certainly correct.

9. Fill up all remaining blanks.

10. Make a neat copy in ink on the duplicate blank, attach Lodge Seal, compare with original carefully, mail the copy to the Grand Secretary, at Louisville, Ky., SEPT. 1, without fail. Present the original to your lodge. Do not detain the return.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS.

Write very plainly all names *in full*.

Remit for dues Oct. 1, or before, by check, money order, or express. If receipt is not promptly returned, write to the Grand Secretary.

An officer can not resign or dimit.

All ministers must pay the assessment.

F. C.'s and E. A.'s are members and pay dues and assessments.

Life and Honorary Members are not recognized by Grand Lodge.

No dues or assessment is required of a brother who has been 50 years a Mason, *provided* the words, "50 years," are written after his name, and in the margin, this information: "Made in ——— Lodge No. ——— at ——— State of ———, ——— 18——." *Not otherwise.*

1. Commence on page 3, read the heading notes and write in *strictly alphabetical order*, the FULL name of every master mason, member of your lodge, including officers and Past Masters, thus:

Adams, Hiram Henry.

2. After the name of ministers who are made "Free Members" by your by-laws, NOT OTHERWISE, write "Rev." thus:

Hunter, Hiram Abif, Rev.

3. Next, on page 7, write alphabetically, the names of F. C.'s, and E. A.'s under those heads respectively.

4. Read the head-notes on pages 8, 9, and enter the names of all who have been *initiated, passed, or raised* during the year, none others, and fill in the dates carefully.

5. On pages 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 appropriately fill the blanks as indicated under each head, designating the "Degree" thus: "P. M." for Past Master, "M. M." for Master Mason, and so on. Do not leave dates, etc., blank.

6. Turn to page 2, and copy the names of officers, and give date of election. Read head-notes under "Past Masters," and fill accordingly.

7. Check off the entire return by the last return to see if no name has been omitted.
