LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE TO GRAND LODGE

Sec. 6. Members. The members of the Grand Lodge are as follows:

- (1) Permanent Members consist of all Past Grand Masters of this Grand Lodge and all Masters and Past Masters of Kentucky lodges who are affiliated with lodges subordinate to this Grand Lodge.
- (2) Representatives are the Master, or in his absence, the Senior Warden, or in their absence the Junior Warden, by virtue of their respective offices.
- (3) An Elective Representative shall be chosen by ballot from the members of a lodge, to represent it in case its Master or a Warden thereof cannot attend the communication of the Grand Lodge, and such representative shall be given a certificate of his election—over the lodge seal. (Constitution Grand Lodge of Kentucky, Sec. 6, pg. 15.)

Kentucky Dear Brother Orton: We are enclosing for your consideration our annual report for the year ended July 31, 1946. It seems advisable to explain the principles followed in the preparation of this report in order that some questions which you might have will be answered. You will find that the names of numerous members have been changed from the style in which they have previously appeared. This applies to given names as well as surnames and it is believed that such changes as made are correct to the best of our knowledge and belief. We have followed the theory that if there were 661 members at July 31, 1945 and 745 now that this report should show any changes made within the current period. Accordingly, we have shown Otis Denniston as an addition (in red) under "Deceased". Likewise, Brothers James C. Diekman, L. S. Haddox, and Roy F. Sharpe have been shown as automatic reinstatements at various dates in 1944, in order to clear the record of something that should have been done two years ago. This does not conform to your instructions pertaining to Otis Denniston, but accomplishes the same purpose, and I hope it will be satisfactory to you this time. We realize that this may not be strictly correct procedure but we hope you will give us the privilege of handling this in such a manner this time. The minutes will disclose such action being taken and they are approved by the craft in open lodge. We have tried to prepare a report for you this time that would be understandable, as I realize that you have not had one of that type from this lodge for many years. However, if there is anything contained in it that is not clear, do not hesitate to write to me and I feel sure that it can be clarified to your entire satisfaction. Dear Brother Secretary:

This Annual Return becomes a permanent record of your lodge in the Grand Secretary's office and may be the only record in existence in the event your lodge records are lost or destroyed, therefore, it is very important that each name and each date be correctly entered, they must be complete in every detail and mailed to the Grand Secretary not later than August 10.

FILL OUT THE TWO COPIES OF THE BLANK RETURNS, file one away for future use and mail the other copy in the addressed envelope enclosed herewith.

THE PAGES MAY BE SEPARATED AND TYPEWRITTEN. The leaves are held together with wire, they may be separated and typewritten, then placed in proper order and the wires replaced. Mail the original typewritten copy, not the carbon copy. Otherwise, they must be written in ink, in plain legible writing.

IMPORTANT. The roster of membership in the annual Proceedings of the Grand Lodge is copied from this Return, therefore, great care should be taken in its preparation, its correctness in facts, dates and spelling, means much to future generations.

PAY FULL POSTAGE ON RETURNS. Returns are rated first class mail and require 3 cents per ounce postage, if they weigh over the one ounce 3 cents will not do.

LIST NAMES IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER, the given name last. Write given name in full instead of initials only. Please do not ditto names. Do not use nick names or pet names. Enter names of your members on the numbered lines and street or R. F. D. and post-office address on the line underneath the name on the same page.

IF A MINISTER, put "Rev." after his name; if a Master Mason affiliated for fifty years, put "Fifty Years" after his name; if in Asylum, put "In Asylum."

LODGES U. D. are governed by the same rule as chartered lodges, except they do not elect officers and do not have a seal.

FIFTY YEAR MEMBERS: Full details giving date and name of lodge in which he was made a Master Mason and names of lodges in which he was affiliated should be furnished the Grand Secretary prior to August 1. (Reg. 162, 163A.)

ALL PRESENT OR ACCOUNTED FOR: Remember the military report at dress parade: "All present or accounted for." So all who were reported as members last year must be present members, or "accounted for" as dead, demitted, suspended or expelled. All who are now members are "ac-

counted for" as having been members per last return or who have become members by initiation, admission or reinstatement.

INCLUDE ONLY ACTUAL WORK DURING THE YEAR, leaving spaces blank (under Initiated, Passed and Raised), where Petition, Entered Apprentice or Fellow-craft degree was reported in previous Return. Do not include work done as a courtesy to other lodges, except as a foot note at the end of your own work.

GRAND LODGE DUES TO BE PAID: \$1.00 on every member whose name is in the list of members in good standing at low twelve July 31, without reference to the date of initiation, reinstatement or affiliation: \$1.00 to the Widows and Orphans' Home, 50 cents to the Masonic Home Journal, and 50 cents to the Old Masons' Home, a total of \$3.00 for each member and \$1.00 for each member raised for the George Washington Memorial.

EXEMPTIONS: Ministers and Rabbis who derive their support from preaching and members who have been affiliated Master Masons in Kentucky lodges for fifty years, are exempt from payment of the \$1.00 Grand Lodge dues, but must pay the W. & O. Home assessment of \$1.00, the Old Masons' Home assessment of 50 cents and the subscription to the Masonic Home Journal of 50 cents. Members confined in hospitals for the insane, honorary members and members in the Armed Service of the U. S., who find it difficult to retain their membership by payment of dues are exempt from both Grand Lodge dues and assessments. Life members and dual members are not exempt from Grand Lodge dues and assessments.

TIME LIMIT FOR FILING RETURNS AND PAYMENT OF DUES AND ASSESSMENTS: Your report will be checked against the one filed last year, the time allotted to our office to complete this work is very short and limited, so get your Return in promptly. It can be mailed during the month of July but must be mailed not later than August 10 (Sec. 146). Your remittance must reach the Grand Secretary's office not later than September 20 (Sec. 139).

PENALTY FOR DELINQUENCY: If any lodge shall fail to comply with any provision of Section 138-139 or 146, it shall immediately be charged with a fine of \$5.00 to be due and payable at once, and in addition thereto said lodge shall be charged one-half of one per cent per month on all unpaid sum or sums until same is paid. If the fine and interest aforesaid are not paid by January 1 next thereafter, the Grand Master shall forthwith arrest the charter of such delinquent lodge. (Sec. 140, Amended 1934.)

YOUR COOPERATION NECESSARY: The work in our office during August and September, while the returns are being received and checked, is extremely heavy and cooperation on your part in forwarding returns promptly and answering by return mail any letters of inquiry with reference to corrections to complete your report, will be greatly appreciated.
