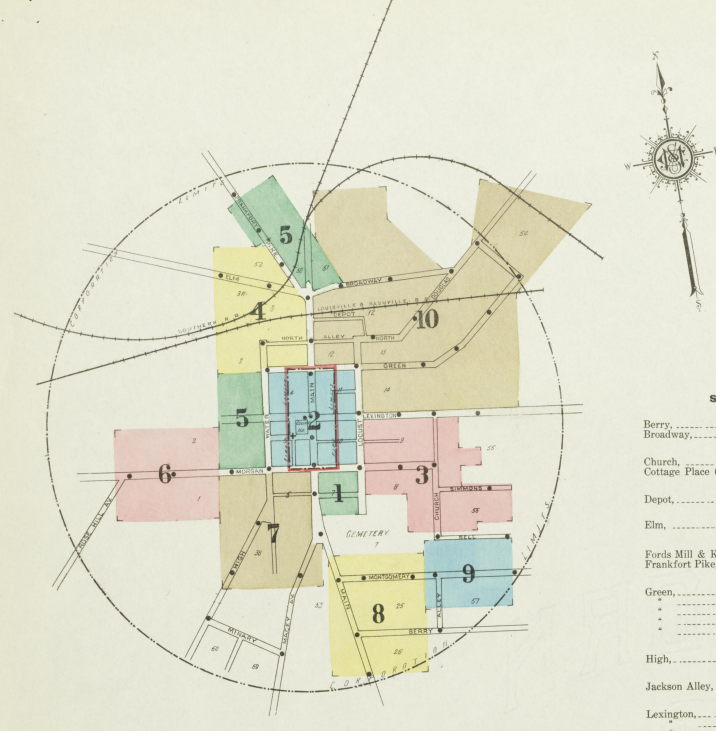

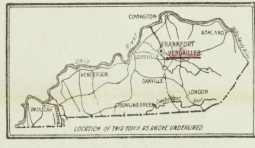


WATER FACILITIES:
System owned by town supply from natural spring located in center of town & 2 driven wells. Water from spring flows into 2000 gal. reservoir under pumping station. Reservoir is also supplied by two compressors with 10 hp pumping capacity, of 500 gal. per minute drawing from wells. 2 1/2 hp. steam P. 5 size 12 1/2" dia. cap, 380 lbs. per square inch pump from reservoir through 4" dia. valve & 10000 gal. W.T. elev. 85 above ground & 48" above business portion of town, giving pressure of 83 lbs. per square inch domestic use. Direct pumping pressure for fire purposes 120 lbs. per square inch. Average daily consumption 60000 gal. per 24 hours. System installed in 1908. 500' 4" x 4" 1/2" mains & 8" double hydrants.

FIRE DEPT:
Volunteer force & paid for actual services required. 10 men plus: 1 engine, 2nd class (assessors) 1st class & driver-truck, 2 hose carts carrying 800' 2" & 200' 2 1/2" hose respectively. Alarm sounded by telephone & bell on Court Ho. Main & macadamized others in good condition. Public lights electric.

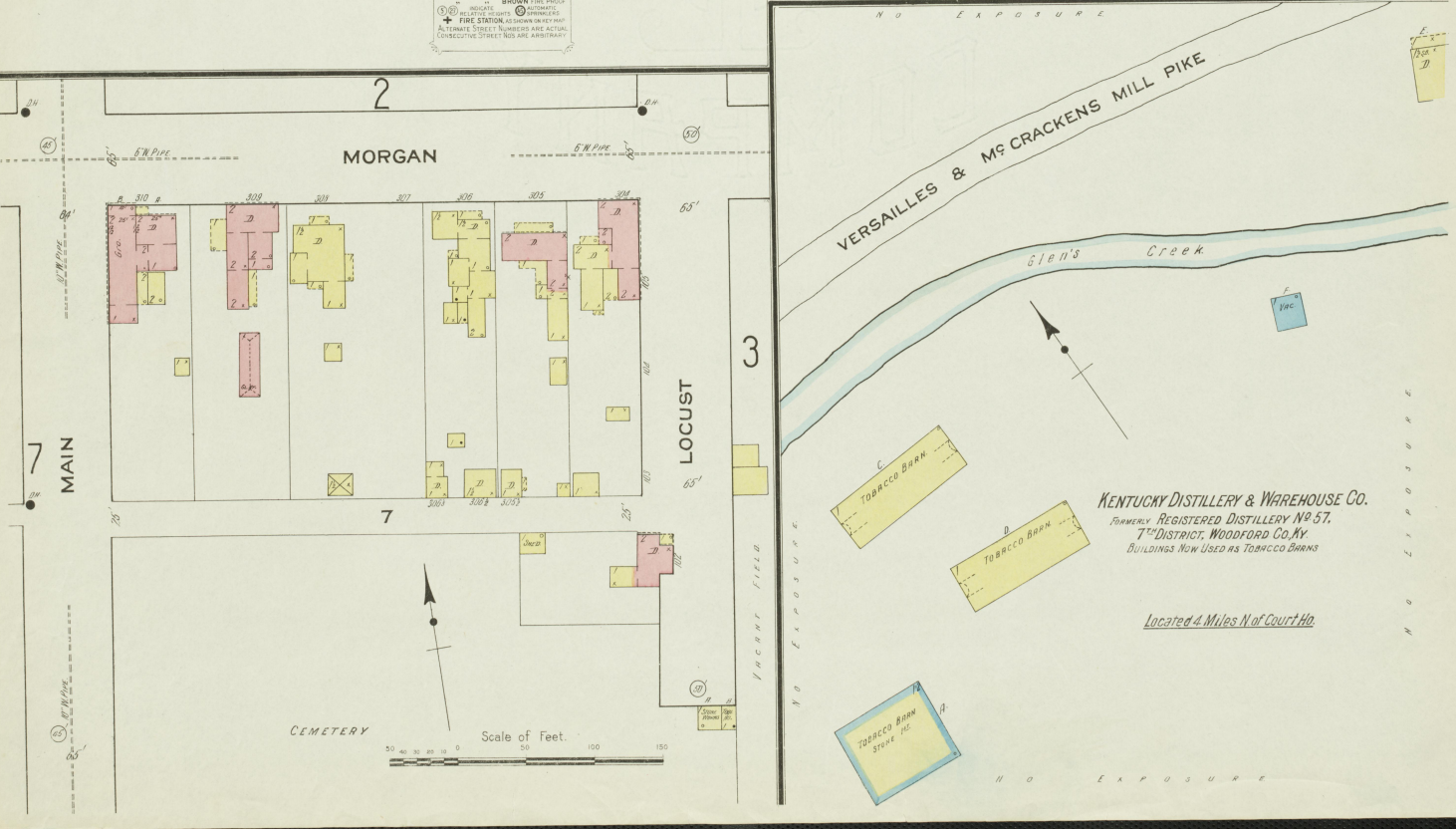

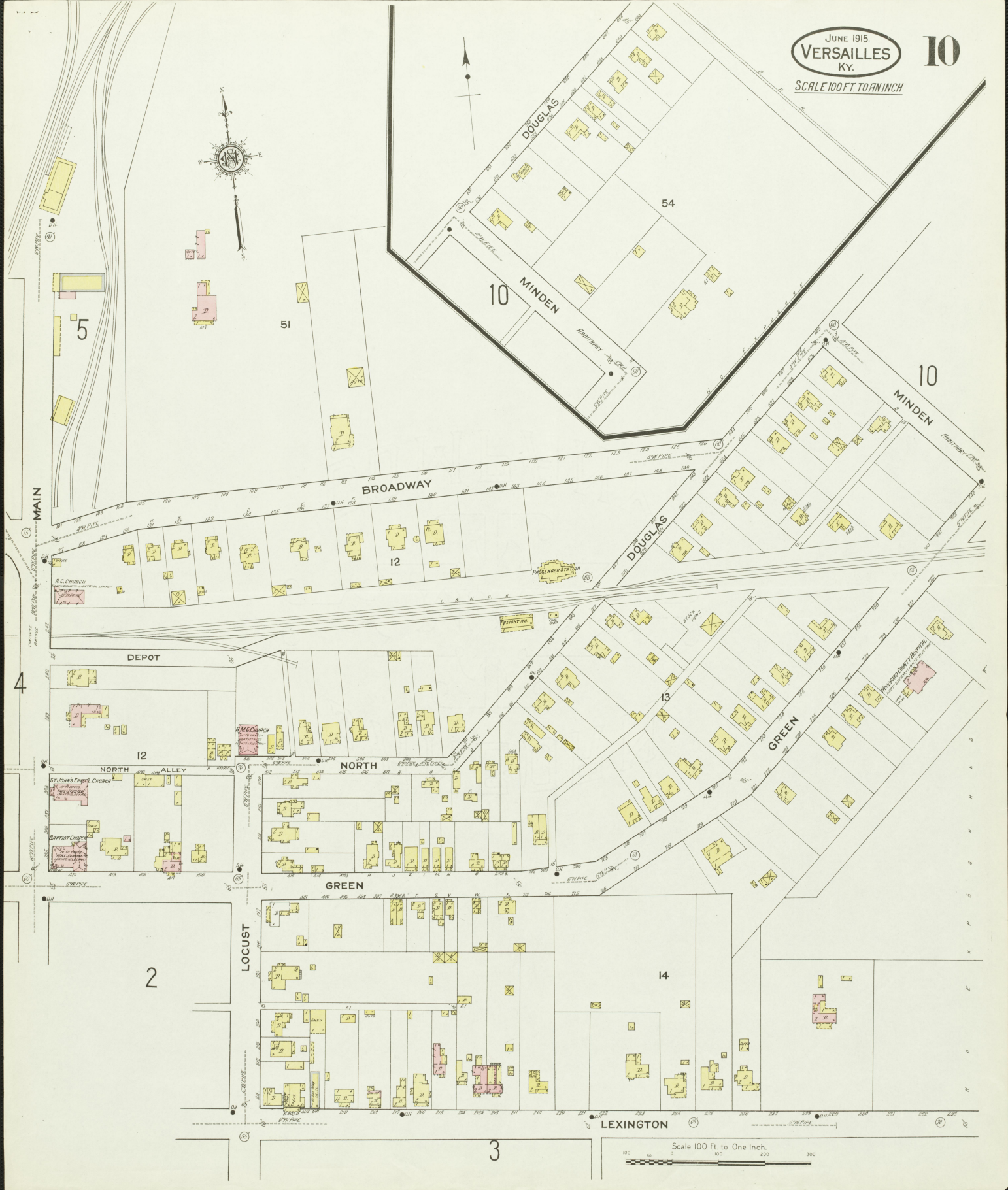
