My Dear Wife,

I write from the stable on Monmouth Park which is situated on the bank of a large pond (hence neuralgia's) I passed a tolerably comfortable night at my lodging house in Swan Pond, but this morning the pains in my face & head have continue with unabated vigour, and I am trying by the help of Heaven to suffer patiently.

It is drizzling rain & the wind N East off the Ocean. Mercury 68.

I wrote to you yesterday evening & only write now supplementary to that letter.

I have written to Mr A F Hawkins the Cashier of the Northern Bank in Lexington requesting him to give notice to the parties who owe me \$7000 & 6 Mrs interest thereon, the 1<sup>st</sup> of August.
