Dean White presented resolutions on the death of Dr. Lovaine Lewis which the Faculty approved for spread upon the minutes.

RESOLUTIONS ON THE DEATH OF DR. LOVAINE CAROL LEWIS
For the Faculty of Arts and Sciences

On March 8th, 1965, the University, and particularly the Department of Physical Education, lost through death a much beloved teacher and colleague. Her contributions to the College will be most difficult to replace. Her loss is immeasurable.

Lovaine's ability to counsel students put her in a position of great respect by students she taught as well as those she served as advisor. Her work with the Women's Athletic Association established this as one of the outstanding student organizations on our campus. Her influence will be felt for many years to come.

Lovaine received all of her formal schooling at the University of Kentucky, which she loved most dearly.

Her service in U.S.O. during World War II gave her insight and skill in dealing with groups of all kinds.

As a teacher Lovaine was able to bring students to a realization of their potential for good, honest effort. She was kindly but firm and always demanded the students' best. Many have expressed their appreciation for her understanding and encouragement.

She was never one to squelch change, creativity or new ideas fostered by the staff or by students, yet she was always quick to observe the practical aspects of any plan and to point out likely problems that would have to be faced in effecting this plan. Her approach was always pragmatic as well as logical.

Like her father, the late Professor Chester A. Lewis, who was a faculty member of the College of Agriculture, Lovaine possessed a quiet sense of humor which seemed to be always ready, especially in trying or critical moments of debate or conversation.

Her services to many professional organizations were unlimited. She held the highest offices in many and will be especially remembered by the Kentucky Folk Association, the American Camping Association, and the Kentucky Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation. More recently, she gave support to the Kentucky Art and Crafts Guild.

It is recommended that the resolutions be spread upon the minutes of this body and a copy sent to the family with deepest sympathy from each faculty member.

The Chairman asked the Senate to stand in a moment of silent tribute in acceptance of these resolutions.

Dean White presented a motion to waive the two-drop rule in the case of Chapman O. Burnett. The Senate approved the recommendation.

Dean White presented a motion to waive the "30 of the last 36 credits must be earned on the Lexington campus" rule for Patricia Burns Seifert because of her high standing, 3.9. He moved that she be allowed to take her last nine hours by extension and correspondence. The Senate approved the recommendation.

Dean White presented a motion that RTF 535 which was approved on February 11, 1965, for a change in credits from two to three be effective for the Spring Semester, 1964-65. The motion was approved.

Dr. Ward moved that the Senate approve Ph.D. Programs in German and Mechanical Engineering, effective September, 1966, provided the Departments recruit sufficient staff members as set forth in the circulated minutes. The Senate approved the motion.

Dr. Ward presented two further recommendations from the Senate Council which will be circulated:

1. That the courses in Medicine 315, 316, 317, 318, 322, 328, and 339, which are a part of a new program in Physical Therapy to be administered by the Topical Major Committee in the College of Arts and Sciences, be approved.

2. That the proposed mathematics requirements for admission to the College of Engineering not become effective until September, 1966. The Council considers the changes to be desirable but feels that it is now too late to make them mandatory for September, 1965, though adherence to them may at once be encouraged as far as is feasible.

If, after ten days following the circularization of these two recommendations, there are no objections, the Senate Council recommends approval. The Senate approved the recommendation.

Dean Shaver asked if the Senate Council had overlooked in the first recommendation the Master's Degree in Engineering Mechanics. Dr. Ward stated that it should have been included and recommended approval. The Senate approved the recommendation.

The Senate adjourned at 4:25 p.m.
