We have received through

& Thirty Eight <sup>40<sup>cts</sup></sup> Dollars being the amount of the Cash  
Payment on your Policy due here on the 6<sup>th</sup> Inst<sup>o</sup>  
Mr Alexander also stated that he had a letter from you  
for us, which was in his baggage but that he had  
lost his baggage, & just as soon as he recovered it he would  
deliver the letter. We presume that you enclosed the note  
in said letter & as we may not have the note in time we

us by mail, we understand that you are now residing in  
Denver City which is out of the limits of your Policy. If you  
intend to reside there you will have to pay 1% Extra  
Premium upon the amount of your Policy which will be  
One Hundred Dollars. Mr John Sharp pays 1%  
Extra Prem<sup>m</sup> on his Policy. If you send us One Hundred Dollars  
more we will send you a Permit, which you had better have  
and be on the safe side.
