After a general discussion in reference to the eligibility of Mr. Ferris, President Barker appointed a special committee to investigate the records of Mr. Ferris and report at the next meeting. Members of the Committee - Professors Boyd, Frankel, Tuthill, Jones and Carroll.

The Registrar stated that the records in the Department of Physical Education for the years 1912-13 and 1913-14 were incomplete; also that a number of men had been excused



from drill on account of work, and asked for faculty ruling in regard to these deficiencies both in gymnasium and drill. On motion of Dr. Kastle, seconded by Professor Anderson, it was voted to exempt the present senior class from gymnasium work, and that President Barker, Lieutenant Underwood and the Registrar handle all questions pertaining to their deficiencies in drill.

The final resolution for the Athletic Committee was read, and on motion of Dr. Kastle, was adopted:

"BE IT RESOLVED by the Athletic Committee of State University, that the President be requested to appoint an Advertising Committee for the University, and that the General Faculty be requested to pass a rule prohibiting any student or students from advertising any University function or soliciting advertising on any program purporting to be for a University function without permission of the Faculty Committee first having been obtained."
