The faculty met in regular monthly session in the President's room in the College Building at 3:30 pm.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were read ^{and} approved.

"The Kentuckian" Prof. Kastle reported that the Committee appointed to determine the relations existing between the College and the Kentuckian had not met to consider the matter for ^{the} reason that the Chairman had not fully understood what was desired, and also for the reason that the faculty knows about as much already about said relations as it would be possible to learn by an investigation.

On motion of Prof. Mathews the report was accepted.

College paper. Ordered on motion of Prof Anderson that the Committee appointed Sept 19, composed of Professors Kastle, Rank White, Nevilcke, be requested and authorized to define the relations which shall exist between any paper purporting to be a college paper and the college authorities. And that the conclusions of this committee if adopted by the Faculty be communicated to the Editor of the Kentuckian.

Prof Anderson reported that Mr L. K. Frankel is doing ^{work} as a candidate for a Master's degree.

Prof Brooks reported that Mr. R. K. Madley is doing work as a candidate for a degree. C. G.

The Secretary of the Scientific Faculty submitted the following which was approved, viz

At the meeting of the Scientific Faculty upon Nov 28 - a discussion was held in regard to the relation of accredited Schools to this College and upon motion it was voted that this Faculty recommend to the general faculty that the Committee upon accredited Schools be reinforced, since the withdrawal of Prof Muncy from active teaching by the addition of Prof. White and Mackenzie,

Voted on motion that the order of examinations observed hitherto be followed this year with the provision that afternoon ^{instead of 1st hour} classes be examined on Monday the 17th.
