



A portion of the Garver-Gambill stone is reproduced on the jacket of Burton Milward's 1989 publication, *History of the Lexington Cemetery*. The stone was placed in the cemetery in 1923, and an excerpt from a Lexington Granite Company letter at that time reads: "...This is the finest piece of work of this description in Central Kentucky, and we are proud that it will go up in the Lexington Cemetery."
