continued.

The Faculty met in called session at 8:30 a.m. The object of the meeting was to take action on the case of Mr. Bush, which had been referred to the Board of Discipline. Prof. Anderson, on whose motion the matter had come before the Faculty on Oct. 4, stated the charges of disorderly conduct and disobedience to orders in the Mechanical Laboratory. Prof. Mills and Mr. Bush both made statements bearing upon the case. Prof. Kestle moved the adoption of the recommendation of the Board of Discipline, to the effect that Mr. Bush be dismissed from College. On motion the Faculty adjourned till 8 a.m., Thursday, under the resolution requiring an interval of twenty-four hours before a vote is taken in such cases.
