Dean Kirwan presented for the Committee on Student Organizations a recommendation that the Student Union Board be permitted to revise its constitution.

The STUDENT UNION BOARD wishes to revise its Constitution in the following manner.

The proposed Fourth Amendment would revise the Student Union Constitution for Article V, Sec. 1, 2, 4 (page 2); 7 (page 3) and Amendments I and II (page 4).

Article V, Sec. 1 and 2, Membership and Elections would read:

Fourth Amendment

Membership and Elections - The Board of Directors shall be constituted as follows: Five (5) student members elected by the student body of the University from a ballot of ten names nominated by the Student Union Board; not more than five (5) student members appointed by the retiring Student

Union Board; two (2) faculty members appointed by the President of the University from a list of four nominees submitted by the Student Union Board; four (4) ex-officio members (the Dean of Women, the Dean of Men, the Union Director and the Social Director). Student members at the time of entrance to the Board shall be at least a Junior, have an accumulative standing of 1.5 or its equivalent and must have shown interest through some work in connection with the Student Union Board and its activities. The date of the annual election shall be fixed by the Board and shall be held in the month of April.

Sec. 4 Voting power - The voting power shall be vested exclusively in the total number of active members of the Board of Directors. An active director may vote by a written general proxy.

Sec. 7 Quorum - A quorum shall be a majority of the number of active members, omitting the president. The president is an ex-officio member of all committees and so may not be counted in the quorum.

The Faculty approved the Committee's recommendation.

The Faculty also approved the recommendation of the Committee on Student Organizations that a new student organization, to be known as the Pence Physics Club, be recognized as an official University organization.

In the absence of Dean Cooper, Assistant Dean Horlacher presented the following recommendations from the College of Agriculture and Home Economics for new courses and changes in courses.

New Course Number

Home Economics 1, Principles of Nutrition. 3 credits  
A non-technical course that treats of the essentials of adequate diet for optimum health, food plans to meet nutritional needs and environmental factors which affect nutrition. Not open to home economics majors. (This is the same course as Home Economics 101.)

Change in Course Numbers

Change Animal Industry 181 to 281, Animal Nutrition (3 credits)

Change Animal Industry 182 to 282, Laboratory Methods in Animal Nutrition (3 credits)

Change Animal Industry 281a-b-c, Research in Animal Nutrition to 284a-b-c (3 credits each)

Change Animal Industry 282, Advanced Animal Nutrition to 283 (3 credits)

The University Faculty approved the recommendations from the College of Agriculture and Home Economics.

Dean Terrell presented for the College of Engineering the following recommendations, which were approved by the University Faculty.

Change of Title and Course Description:

Metallurgical Engineering 166 - Minerals Beneficiation. (5 sem. hrs.)  
Study of the theory of mineral dressing and of the machines used in preparing crude minerals for market is supplemented by reference reading to acquaint the student with the application of theory to the problems of preparing specific minerals. Consideration is given to the principles of design of mineral preparation plants. Lecture and recitation, five hours. Prerequisites: Chemistry 21a, Physics 3b, and Met. Eng. 26 or Met. Eng. 27.

Change of Title, Credit and Course Description:


Metallurgical Engineering 167 - Minerals Beneficiation Laboratory.  
(1 sem. hr.)  
The theories of mineral dressing are applied in the laboratory: accompanying Met. Eng. 166. The approach to practical problems in mineral dressing is emphasized. Laboratory, two hours. Prerequisite or concurrent: Met. Eng. 166.

New Courses:

Electrical Engineering 103 - Electrical Laboratory for Mining Engineers.  
(1 sem. hr.)  
A laboratory study of circuits and equipment used in the servicing and operation of industrial equipment. With special emphasis on mining applications. Laboratory: three hours. Concurrent: Elec. Eng. 102.

Mining Engineering 132 - Mine Rescue Training and First Aid. (No credit)  
This course is required of all mining engineers, and covers the fundamental principles of mine rescue training and first aid, to be given on the University campus by the Kentucky Department of Mines and Minerals, the U. S. Bureau of Mines or both in collaboration. Prerequisite: Junior or Senior Classification.
