turned up 26,334 current or recent federal workers on welfare folls, IRWS Secretary Joseph Califano Jr., announced yesterday.

They made up 1.4 percent of the 1.8 million federal workers whose names were checked by computer against records of Za million welfare recipients in 20 states and the District of Columbia. There are 2.7 million federal workers and 11.2 million persons in the Aid to Families with Dependent Children program.

Califano said many federal workers with large families and love paying jobs may be entitled to the benefits. He said he does not think federal workers are "more fraud prone than any other group of citizens."






