

Nov 1st Saturday --- Saw Maj Hays, he advised me to go to Murfreesboro and await him, left for M at 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ p. m.

Nov 2nd Sunday --- Got to Chattanooga at 5 o'clock A M. Stopped at Central House ---

Nov 3rd Monday --- left for Murfreesboro Staid this night at Bridgeport Ala --- slept out ---

Nov 4th Tuesday --- Arrived at Tullahoma Tenn --- staid this night at Hotel there

Nov 5th Wednesday --- Started for Murfreesboro --- in a Spring wagon --- with C. D. Kirk --- W D Chipley and Capt Jack Thomson, stayed this night in Hotel at Manchester Tenn,

Nov 6th Thursday, Arrived at Murfreesboro at 4 o'clock p m, stopped at City Hotel,

Nov 7th Friday ---- Went out to camp of [H]ansons Brigade 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles --- and put up with Dr Beale --- where I remained until Friday Nov 14th --- On the 10th I wrote a letter to Annie --- to be carried through by a gentleman going to Owensboro Ky.

Nov 14th Friday --- Left M___ and went to Estill Springs (near Tullahoma) where Gen'l Buckners Division was camped --- Stayed all night with Maj Hays ---

Nov 15th Saturday --- Maj Hays appointed me Forage Master --- to issue Forage to Staff Horses --- and I commenced duties of the station

Nov 16th Sunday --- Saw in Murfreesboro paper [er] copied from Louisville Journal --- that Mr Wherritt had been released from Camp Chase and got home on 5th of Nov ---

Nov 17th Monday --- Being convinced that I did not suit the position of Forage Master and very certain that it did not suit me,
