

me to be at the camp - by 6 o'clock A.M. next day, and he would give me a place in the Q.M.s department - I staid 2 miles from there
Oct 13th Monday - The army commenced its retreat last night at 12 o'clock, and when I got to Genl Buckners I found them gone - as I had neither horse or money I accepted Mrs Cromwells invitation to go with him and Brooks in their wagon - we started about 8 o'clock A.M. - on the road to Lancaster I met W & Chinn of Frankfort and borrowed of [redacted] Confederate money - and as I [redacted] it was very acceptable - when we got to [redacted] - found that the army divided, part going by Stamford and [redacted] by Richmond - not being able to [redacted] -tain which way Genl Buckners Division went - I took the route to Richmond with [redacted] B.
 Camped at night on Mrs Burnside's farm 10 miles from Lancaster -

Oct 14th Tuesday - Arrived at Richmond, [redacted] supper at Sam Wherritts - Camped near town on Mrs Shephens place - wrote Annie -

Oct 15th Wednesday, Left R at 12 o'clock, wrote Annie by James Miller of Harrison Co, before leaving, Camped 10 miles from Richmond

Oct 16th Thursday - Commenced ascending "12th Hill at 12 o'clock, camped at 4 o'clock 22 miles out from Richmond

Oct 17th Friday, Started at 2 o'clock A.M. crossed Rockcastle River at 1 o'clock, Camped at 6 o'clock - 6 miles from River in Rockcastle Co
