Oct 25th Saturday, Started at 6 o'clock A.M.
arrived in Knoxville at 8 o'clock A.M.

Found the place crowded — universal cornu-
nation of Braggs campaign in Ky — Many deter-
-mining to go back — Staid in Knoxville until

Oct 29th in hope of seeing May Hays —

Oct 29th Wednesday — Left Knoxville for Chattanooga —
-nooga — went as far as Cleveland Tenn, with
Cromwell & Brooks who were destined for
Atlanta Ga — arrived at Chattanooga at
9 1/2 o'clock p.m. —

Oct 30th Thursday — Started at 4 o'clock
A.M. — went to Catoosa Springs to see May
Hays — did not find him — and went
on to Atlanta Ga. arriving at 2 1/2 A.M. on

me to go to Murfreesboro and await him,
