I am glad to know that they are hitting the German and the Jap hard now and let me know more news about the war. It might be the best to not try to get me out of the army it does not make me ~~mad~~ <sup>mad</sup> ~~that~~ I don't want the people to get in trouble on account of me. How is that you can not get more than two tabs?

I just it will be the last  
check you ~~will~~ will get for  
a while for I drop my \$40.00  
allowance there will be  
some one out to check up on  
~~what~~ what you was doing  
with the money that I would  
send home do not ~~still~~ tell  
them that you was getting  
the money in the bank for  
me tell them you was using  
it to live on. I had to  
say when you was born  
I said that dad was born  
on nov 11-1872 and mother  
was born on may 8-1877 so  
tell them the same way I  
don't no if I said a lay or  
not and I said you depend  
on me 75%.

I went to school for four<sup>4</sup> day  
on a first aid so I am a first  
aid man now but I wish  
that I would not pas the  
task. I jest I will close  
for this time write when  
you can. from your son.

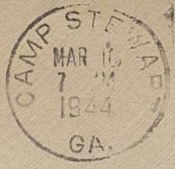
March 12-1964

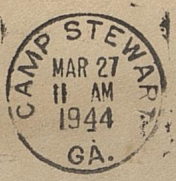

you all.

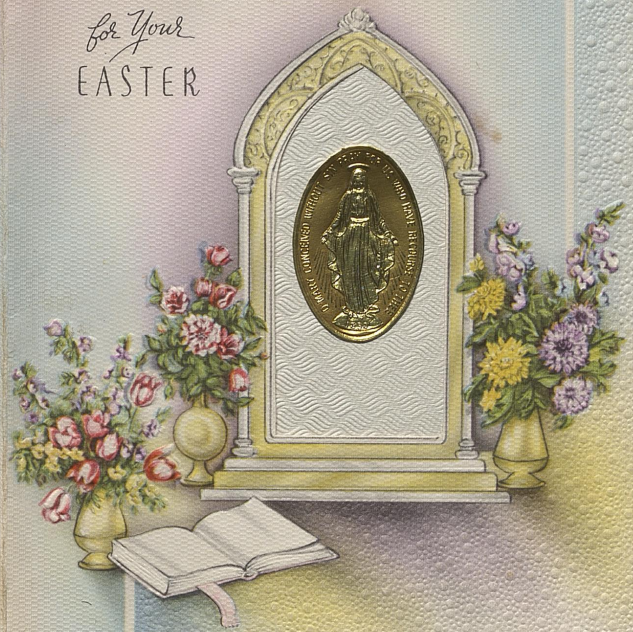

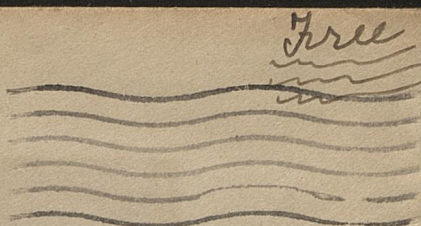
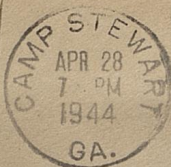
Dear, mother, Father and Brother.
