is sell hot here in miss.

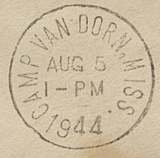

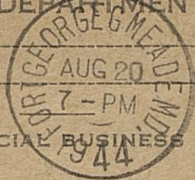

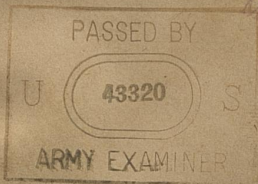
