PREFACE

Because, as recently as 1938, there appeared a good list of Iowa imprints earlier than 1861, it seems logical for the American Imprints Inventory to offer as its first contribution to the record of pioneer printing in Iowa, a list of imprints supplementary to the already published list.

The earlier list to which reference is made was compiled by Alexander Moffit, now on the staff of the University of Texas Library. It was published under the title, "A Checklist of Iowa Imprints, 1837-1860" in the January, 1938, issue of the <u>Iowa Journal of History and Politics</u>, p.3-95. The work on the list was done while the compiler was a graduate student at the University of Illinois Library School.

The present list of Iowa imprints for the same period in supplement to the Moffit list constitutes the fifteenth in the series of check lists issued by the American Imprints Inventory of the WPA Historical Records Survey. As will be seen, it records 195 imprints not listed by Moffit, and gives 586 additional locations for 239 titles in his list, 82 of which are for one title, No. 402. This should be regarded as a first contribution, for some additional imprints are bound to come to light during the future of our work.

Since Iowa public documents were omitted from the Moffit list, our supplement is also restricted to the record of non-official imprints.

The first printing in Iowa was done in 1836 at Dubuque, just recently settled by men who had come to work the rich lead mines at

that point. John King, one of the settlers, returned to Ohio to purchase a press and engage a printer in the person of William Cary Jones of Chillicothe. King also employed another printer, Andrew Keesecker, who had been working across the river at Galena, Illinois. These men brought out the first issue of the <u>Du Buque Visitor</u> on May 11, 1836.

We will not here undertake to trace further the history of the early press of Iowa. Suffice it to say that Burlington became in 1837 the second printing point in the area which was to become the state of Iowa, and that in the same year Davenport became the third.

Towa libraries hold over one half of the titles listed below, or 99, of which 72 are, according to present information, unique copies. The majority of these are located in three collections, the State Historical Society of Iowa (30 titles, 24 unique), the Iowa State Historical, Memorial, and Art Department (19 titles, 12 unique), and the Putnam Museum (18 titles, 17 unique). Of the 195 titles listed, 148 are so far located in one copy only. The largest contributions to the present list of titles in depositories outside of Iowa are those of the Samuel Colgate Baptist Historical Collection at Hamilton, N.Y. (19 titles, 16 unique), and of the American Baptist Historical Society at Chester, Pa.(13 titles, 8 unique).

The greater part of the editorial work on this list was done by Don Farran of the editorial staff of the American Imprints Inventory.

The index of printers and presses refers to imprints in both the Moffit list and the present list.

Since another supplement will be issued, it is hoped that notes regarding titles as yet undescribed, notations of errors, and additional locations of titles listed, will be forwarded to the undersigned at 433 East Erie Street, Chicago.
