Additional duties.

And it was further ordered that inasmuch as the compensation attached to the appointment of Miss Kinkead as Lecturer on English Literature is large and such additional duties in connection with the Department of English be assigned to her as will make a fair equivalent for the salary allowed, and that these duties be defined and set forth by the Executive Committee after conference with Prof. MacKenzie and Miss Kinkead.
